Darby Private Equity: Company Overview

Darby Overseas Investments, Ltd. ("Darby") was founded in 1994 by Nicholas F. Brady, former Secretary of the United States Department of Treasury, and is a global emerging markets private equity, private debt and infrastructure fund manager with offices in Latin America, Central & Eastern Europe and Asia, with over US\$ 6.5 billion in cumulative capital commitments.

Darby was acquired by Franklin Templeton in 2003 and is currently a wholly owned subsidiary of Franklin Resources, Inc. ("Franklin Templeton"). Franklin Templeton is a global fund manager and a publicly traded company, listed on the New York Stock Exchange (ticker: BEN) and part of the S&P 500 index. Franklin Templeton currently has over US\$ 700 billion under management, clients in more than 170 countries, spread through offices in over 30 countries, including Brazil. Combining local and offshore vehicles, Franklin Templeton is among the largest foreign investors in Brazil.

Internship Description

The current internship position is for the Infrastructure Group. The intern will work directly with the local investment team, as well as with the global Darby team, participating in investments and divestments, including sector specific analysis, transaction due diligence, financial modeling and portfolio monitoring.
